- 04-05** The Board of Governors of the Federal Reserve System, Federal Financial Institutions Examination Council, Office of the Comptroller of the Currency, and Office of Thrift Supervision issued a statement titled *Interagency Policy on Banks/Thriffs Providing Financial Support to Funds Advised by the Banking Organization or its Affiliates*.
- 04-06** The Board of Governors of the Federal Reserve System, Office of the Comptroller of the Currency, Office of Thrift Supervision, Federal Deposit Insurance Corporation, National Credit Union Administration, Federal Trade Commission, Commodity Futures Trading Commission, and Securities and Exchange Commission requested comment on an interagency proposal to consider alternative forms of privacy notices under the Gramm-Leach-Bliley Act.
- 04-07** The Federal Reserve Banks announced amendments to Operating Circular 3 (*Collection of Cash Items and Returned Checks*).
- 04-08** The Board of Governors and the Federal Trade Commission jointly adopted rules establishing the effective dates for the Fair and Accurate Credit Transactions Act of 2003.
- 04-09** The Federal Reserve, along with the Office of the Comptroller of the Currency, the Federal Deposit Insurance Corporation, and the Office of Thrift Supervision issued an *Interagency Advisory on Accounting for Deferred Compensation Agreements and Bank-Owned Life Insurance*.
- 04-10** The federal bank regulatory agencies announced the availability of a web site that provides information on the Federal Financial Institution's Examination Council's Call Report Modernization initiative.
- 04-11** The Board of Governors of the Federal Reserve System, Office of the Comptroller of the Currency, Federal Deposit Insurance Corporation, and Office of Thrift Supervision published a joint interagency notice of proposed rulemaking regarding the Community Reinvestment Act.
