- 04-29** The Board of Governors of the Federal Reserve System requested public comment on a proposal to allow the continued inclusion of outstanding and prospective issuances of trust preferred securities in the tier 1 capital of bank holding companies.
- 04-30** The Board of Governors of the Federal Reserve System requested public comment on a study and report to Congress regarding pre-screened solicitations for credit or insurance.
- 04-31** The enforcement staffs of the Federal Reserve Board and the other federal financial institutions supervisory agencies, along with the U.S. Department of the Treasury's Financial Crimes Enforcement Network, issued an interagency advisory concerning the legal protections associated with the filings of suspicious activity reports.
- 04-32** The Federal Financial Institutions Examination Council announced the availability of the March 2004 Uniform Bank Performance Report.
- 04-33** The Board of Governors of the Federal Reserve System published revisions to Regulation V, which implements the Fair Credit Reporting Act.
- 04-34** The Board of Governors of the Federal Reserve System, Office of the Comptroller of the Currency, Federal Deposit Insurance Corporation, and Office of Thrift Supervision requested public comment on a proposal to implement Section 216 of the Fair and Accurate Credit Transactions Act of 2003 by amending the Interagency Guidelines Establishing Standards for Safeguarding Customer Information.
- 04-35** The Board of Governors of the Federal Reserve System requested public comment on the adequacy of existing disclosures on debit card fees.
