- 04-84** The Board of Governors announced the names of six new members of its Thrift Institutions Advisory Council and designated a new president and vice president of the council for 2005.
- 04-85** The Board of Governors adopted several revisions to its Policy on Payments System Risk.
- 04-86** The Board of Governors revised its bank holding company rating system to better reflect and communicate its supervisory priorities and practices.
- 04-87** The Board of Governors requested public comment on an advance notice of proposed rulemaking to commence a review of the open-end credit rules of the Board's Regulation Z, which implements the Truth in Lending Act.
- 04-88** The federal banking, thrift, and credit union regulatory agencies published guidance for examiners, financial institutions, and technology service providers on the acquisition and use of free and open source software.
- 04-89** The Board of Governors published new pamphlets for Regulation CC (*Availability of Funds and Collection of Checks*), effective October 2004, and the Capita Adequacy Guidelines, effective September 2004.
- 04-90** The Board of Governors, Office of the Comptroller of the Currency, Federal Deposit Insurance Corporation, and Office of Thrift Supervision requested public comment on proposed changes to the data collection process that supports the Shared National Credit review of large syndicated loans.
- 04-91** The Board of Governors of the Federal Reserve System published its annual notice of the asset-size exemption threshold for depository institutions under Regulation C, which implements the Home Mortgage Disclosure Act.
