To the Chief Executive Officer of the Saving and Loan Holding Company:

A signed/non-published version of the final FR H-(b)11 notice effective for September 30, 2013, has been posted to the Board's public web site <http://www.federalreserve.gov/apps/reportforms/review.aspx> under "Recently Approved and Implemented." While we have received final Board approval, we cannot publish the final notice in the *Federal Register* at this time. The Federal Register Office was affected by the government shutdown. When the government re-opens we will publish the final notice in the *Federal Register*.

The changes effective for September 30, 2013, were implemented as proposed¹. The respondent panel was revised to include only exempt savings and loan holding companies (SLHCs). These SLHCs are required to file the *Quarterly Savings and Loan Holding Company Report* (FR 2320). The FR H-(b)11 panel includes any lower-tier SLHCs subject to the FR H-(b)11 requirements. Additionally, the form and instructions have been modified to reflect the removal of the request for the docket number.

Also effective for September 30, 2013, any supplemental information provided in Item 3 of the FR H-(b)11 in response to a "yes" answer on the FR 2320's questions 24, 25 and 26 is protected from disclosure under exemption 4 of the Freedom of Information Act (FOIA) and should be included in the SLHC's confidential transmission file. However, a letter requesting confidential treatment for this supplemental information is not required. If, however, the SLHC requests confidential treatment for any other part or all of its FR H-(b)11 report, the SLHC is still required to include a letter providing the reason for the request of confidential treatment for that information as part of the confidential transmission file. The transmission will include a 'C' in the file name to indicate that a request for confidential treatment of the data contained in the file.
