



Same school, year-over-year changes

Men declining at 2x the rate of women within every race. Black and Latino men are falling most steeply, while women are on par with Whites.










Institutions – First Time Students





All Undergraduate Students by Gender and Age





Steepest Declines in Undergraduate Enrollment

- Steepest decline so far since the pandemic began
- Spring undergraduate enrollment is down 5.9% compared to the same time last year



- Community Colleges are now the worst-hit sector at 11.3% compared to 9.5% last fall
- Associate Degree enrollment down 10.9% with Baccalaureate Degrees only down 2.2%
- 18-20 year-old students are down 14.6%
- Latino students at Community Colleges were down 13.7% this spring

Key Takeaways

- Community College decline of 9.4%, more than double the overall undergraduate rate (-4%)
- First-Time students down 23%, much steeper than overall (-16%)
- Much steeper than trends over the past 5 years
- All age groups affected, including dual enrollments

- Men affected much more than women
