**Appointments to the Thrift Institutions
Advisory Council and to the Consumer Advisory Council**

DETAILS

The Board of Governors of the Federal Reserve System has announced the appointment of seven new members to its Thrift Institutions Advisory Council and has designated a new president and vice president of the council for 1999.

The council is an advisory group made up of twelve representatives from thrift institutions. The panel was established by the Board in 1980 and includes savings and loan, savings bank, and credit union representatives. The council meets with the Board of Governors at least three times a year to discuss developments relating to thrift institutions, the housing industry, mortgage finance, and certain regulatory issues.

In addition, the Board has announced the appointment of ten new members to its Consumer Advisory Council and has designated a new chair and vice chair of the council for 1999.

The council, which consists of thirty members, advises the Board on the exercise of its responsibilities under the Consumer Credit Protection Act and on other matters concerning consumer financial services. The council meets three times a year in Washington, D.C.
