**DETAILS**

The following is an announcement of Federal Reserve System priced service fee changes for 2002, which will become effective January 2, 2002.

Fees across electronic services will decrease by five percent due to lower 2002 prices for Fedwire® Funds Transfer and Fedwire Book-Entry Securities services. Prices for FedACH™ services, which were recently changed in October 2001, will remain at their current levels.

In Check services, the Eleventh District is pleased to offer several new products/services. A Premium Plus group sort product will allow customers to deposit items drawn on specific RCPC and Country endpoints at a deadline that is consistent with the City-High-Dollar Group Sort deadline for same-day availability.

The Dallas and San Antonio offices will add Nationwide Weekend Sort to their current products. This check deposit product offers financial institutions the convenience of depositing all weekend check items in five cash letters. Nationwide Weekend sort also provides 100 percent availability on Monday for selected sorts and Tuesday for Country endpoints. The Houston office currently offers this product. Information about the new check products can be obtained by contacting your local Business Development representative.

For FedLine® and Computer Interface (CI) customers, current fees for access to the Federal Reserve's FEDNET® network (dial, leased line, and frame relay) will remain unchanged in 2002.

Accounting services will implement several fee changes for 2002. Specifically, fee increases will be implemented for the paper delivery of the IAS Statement of Account Activity and for IAS Cash Management services.

Noncash collection service fees will remain at their current levels.
