#### **2004 Eleventh District Holiday Schedule**

### **DETAILS**

The Federal Reserve Bank of Dallas and its branches at El Paso, Houston, and San Antonio, will not be open on the following holidays in 2004:

January 1	New Year's Day
January 19	Martin Luther King, Jr., Day
February 16	Presidents Day
May 31	Memorial Day
July 5	Independence Day
September 6	Labor Day
October 11	Columbus Day
November 11	Veterans Day
November 25	Thanksgiving Day

The Federal Reserve standard holiday schedule mandates that if January 1, July 4, November 11, or December 25 falls on a Sunday, the following Monday will be observed as a holiday. If January 1, July 4, November 11, or December 25 occurs on a Saturday, the preceding Friday will not be observed as a holiday. For the year 2004, July 4 falls on a Sunday; therefore,

Monday, July 5, will be observed as a holiday. Since December 25 falls on a Saturday, the preceding Friday—December 24—will **not** be observed as a holiday.

Please file this notice for your reference. Individual notices of the holidays listed above will not be sent.
