Business Retention	Rate of increase or decrease in the number of neighborhood businesses from the previous year.	U.S. Census	Economic Health

Commute Mode Share	Proportion of neighborhood residents who commute to work by transit, bicycle, foot, or carpool.	U.S. Census	Transportation

Food Desert	Share of neighborhood without access to affordable or good-quality fresh food (low income/low access).	USDA	Neighborhood Characteristics
High School Graduation Rate	Rate of high school graduation at neighborhood schools.	Local Data	Educational Opportunities
Household Transportation Costs	Proportion of household income residents pay for transportation.	HUD Location Affordability Index (LAI)	Transportation
Local Business Vitality	Proportion of small (0-4 employees), locally-owned businesses in the neighborhood.	U.S. Census	Economic Health

Motor Vehicle Collisions	Annual incidence of motor vehicle collision injuries and fatalities per 10,000 residents for all modes of transportation on public roadways and right-of-ways.	Local Data	Health Systems and Public Safety
Offsite Alcohol Outlets	Number of stores selling alcohol for “off-site” consumption per 10,000 residents.	U.S. Census	Neighborhood Characteristics
Pedestrian Connectivity	Measure of how well sidewalks and streets are connected and intersections spaced to allow residents to easily walk or bike around the neighborhood.	EPA Smart Location Database (SLD)	Transportation
Public Assisted Households	Proportion of neighborhood households receiving public assistance (i.e., Supplemental Security Income (SSI), cash public assistance and/or Food Stamps/SNAP).	Local Data	Employment Opportunities

Preventable Hospitalizations	Age-standardized hospitalization rate for conditions where appropriate out-patient care could have prevented or reduced need for hospital admission.	Local Data	Health Systems and Public Safety
Reading Proficiency	Proportion of third or fourth grade students meeting or exceeding “proficient” reading levels on standardized assessment in neighborhood schools.	Local Data	Educational Opportunities
Residential Mobility	Proportion of residents, age one year and older, living the same house as one year ago.	U.S. Census	Social Cohesion
Residential Proximity to Traffic	Proportion of a residential neighborhood located near heavy traffic roadways.	U.S. Census / Federal Highway Administration	Environmental Hazards

Indicator	Description	Data Source
Concentrated Poverty	Proportion of residents below the poverty level.	U.S. Census
Income Inequality	Measure of inequality based on the dispersion of household income within the community.	U.S. Census (Gini Index)
Life Expectancy	Count of years of potential life lost per capita.	Local Data
Park Quality	Proprietary city park score that integrates and evaluates park acreage, land share, spending per resident, playgrounds, and park proximity.	Trust for Public Land Park Score
Racial/Ethnic diversity	Measure of the extent to which several racial/ethnic groups are present in the community.	U.S. Census

Note: A cumulative ranking of the core HCI Indicators provides a single measure for which neighborhoods within a city can compare themselves to each other. Only core indicators are used in the ranking process; Demographic and Contextual Measures were created to help provide a better sense of the conditions, challenges, and opportunities within each neighborhood.
