
BUILD YOUR TORNADO KIT: A CHECKLIST



Single mom Lindsay Diaz and her baby Arian huddled in the bathtub as the tornado tore through their house.

Lindsay decided to repair, not rebuild, her duplex after an engineer told her it was structurally sound. The day she filed the permits, her home was mistakenly demolished by a wrecking crew.

Jessica Cadick and Charles Beck have three young kids. The tornado seriously damaged their rental house and they didn't have renter's insurance. Beck, who's a contractor, only had a liability policy on his work truck, which was flattened.



Alfredo and Anthony Fowler-Rainone owned their home free and clear when the tornado slammed into their neighborhood. They have homeowner's insurance, but found their policy left them about \$20K short on rebuilding costs.
